RENO/TAHOE INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT

The Airport Authority of Washoe County has prepared an update to the Airport Noise Compatibility Program for the Reno/Tahoe International Airport, based on the requirements and guidelines of Part 150 of the Federal Aviation Regulations. A series of planning advisory committee, citizen advisory committee, and public workshop meetings were held through the 18 month study process to formulate the program recommendations. Program recommendations include noise abatement measures intended to reduce noise levels or shift the location of noise to more compatible areas. The recommended Program also proposes several land use management measures intended to mitigate the impacts of noise on current residents of noise-impacted areas and to regulate land development to reduce the potential of noise impacts in the future.
