The Reno-Tahoe Airport Authority (RTAA) Contracts & Procurement Department, in accordance with the provisions of NRS Chapter 338, is currently accepting sealed Bids from qualified Contractors, per NRS §338.1382 and licensed to work in the State of Nevada, to provide construction services including removing existing asphalt pavement, excavation, stabilizing fill, base material, utility work, apron and parking lot pavements, drainage, markings, apron lighting, and ancillary work associated with the Project, and to provide all material, labor, tools, expendable equipment, transportation services, permits and fees, utilities required, and all incidental items necessary to provide the Scope of Work entitled “GA East Apron/Taxilane Reconstruction.”
